Thanks to the generous philanthropic support of many individuals, King Edward VII's Hospital is proud to be able to continue its 120 years' tradition of providing life-changing medical treatment to the men and women who have served this country. Our goal is to increase the number of veterans we help by 40% over the next five years.

Through the ground-breaking Veterans' Pain Management Programme (PMP) and our Military Grants, which enable us to provide complex surgical procedures to veterans, we help on average 160 veterans each year. For many, the treatment they receive is life-changing.

Up to 60 veterans each year are able to participate in the PMP, which gives them the tools to reduce their pain medication, to manage their pain, to feel more confident, and be more engaged with their family and friends. Up to July 2019, 317 veterans have been assessed and 187 veterans have attended a PMP. Two programmes are already funded, but we need to raise funds to run a further four programmes each year.

Since 2014, we have also helped 447 men and women by providing grants and subsidies in order that they may benefit from an extensive range of surgeries, procedures and investigations with leading consultants. Orthopaedics, ophthalmology, urology and ENT have been among the most called-upon areas of our medical expertise. We are enormously grateful that some of the Hospital's consultants are willing to offer to treat veterans pro bono.

We are delighted to be working with many military charities, including ABF The Soldiers Charity, SSAFA, Blesma, Blind Veterans UK, Veterans Aid, and Help for Heroes, to name but a few, who help us to reach those who are unable to receive timely and effective treatment elsewhere and therefore need our help the most. Veterans come to us from across the United Kingdom.

This vital work can only be delivered with the help of charitable donations. As a charity, the support we receive is our lifeblood.
