




Our ethos is one of teamwork, our nurses working with clinicians, technicians and therapists to provide patients with the best possible evidenced-based, individualised care.

Our hospital's multi-disciplinary team of hand-picked, leading orthopaedic surgeons, specialist radiologists and physiotherapists work together for rapid assessment, diagnosis and treatment of all musculoskeletal conditions. Procedures include but are not limited to:

- · Hip replacement and resurfacing
- · Knee replacement, ACL and multiligament reconstruction
- Spinal surgery
- · Hand and wrist trauma
- Foot and ankle surgery
- Shoulder and elbow arthroscopy and replacement
- Bone infection, non-union, fractures and limb reconstruction

With access to a range of the latest diagnostic imaging on-site, our orthopaedic consultants have everything they need to make a diagnosis and tailor a treatment plan specific to individual patients' needs.


Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS) and On-site Hydrotherapy

As one of very few private hospitals to offer on-site Hydrotherapy, we can deliver vital rehabilitation following surgeries such as knee or hip replacements. Our CNS's and physiotherapists work closely with our orthopaedic consultants to provide an unparalleled, seamless service.









Urology

King Edward VII's Hospital is one of the UK's leading centres for urology, bringing together an exceptional multi-disciplinary team of consultant urologists who are all leaders in their specialist field.

Collaborating to offer an integrated service, and with the very latest in diagnostic and surgical technology at their fingertips, the Hospital's consultant urologists work together with specialist nurses to provide care at the cutting edge of modern medicine. The Hospital has the full armamentarium for the surgical treatment of localised prostate cancer, from focal therapy to robotic radical prostatectomy. A multidisciplinary team will review all new prostate cancer cases for the suitability for various treatments.


Women's health

Gynaecology

King Edward VII's Hospital has a highly specialised team of consultant gynaecologists who have all been hand-picked to treat patients and a wide range of gynaecological conditions. Our gynaecological care is delivered by recognized experts in pelvic floor dysfunction, urinary incontinence, fibroids, endometriosis, colposcopy, complex gynaecology surgery and reconstruction.

We have an especially high concentration of expertise in gynaecological oncology. Patients affected by gynaecological cancers are supported along their entire journey by leading consultants in their field both nationally and internationally, and a highly specialised clinical team, continuously striving for the best possible diagnosis and surgical treatment.

The King Edward VII's Hospital Endometriosis Centre

Our Endometriosis Centre provides a multidisciplinary approach to the diagnosis and treatment of patients with endometriosis. Our expert consultant gynaecologists lead the service and work with a named colorectal surgeon and consultant urologists to support patients with a more severe degree of endometriosis involving the bowel and bladder.

Our specialists work with patients to create a holistic programme that is personally tailored to their individual lifestyle and needs.










Digestive Health

Endoscopy

A centre of excellence in advanced and therapeutic endoscopy

King Edward VII's Hospital offers state-of-the-art endoscopy with the latest technology including magnification endoscopy at 80-100 x zoom for assessments of gastrointestinal polyps. We have the expertise to offer advanced therapeutic endoscopy including endoscopic mucosal resection (EMR), endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD) for treatment of complex polyps and early cancer, and peroral endoscopic myotomy (POEM) for treatment of achalasia.

The purpose built unit allows complete examination of the upper gastrointestinal (GI) tract or the lower GI tract. Our specialist consultants offer a comprehensive set of endoscopic investigations which allow them to make accurate diagnoses.

Critical Care


We have a fully equipped 4 bed Critical Care Unit which is able to provide comprehensive enhanced patient care. We also provide ward level Critical Care Outreach, for those patients who require extra care or monitoring within the ward or after their transfer from our Critical Care Unit.

Our Critical Care unit is staffed by a team of dedicated Critical Care Nurses, who are managed by a Senior Clinical Nurse Manager and overseen by experienced Consultant Intensivists. There is also a specialist Resident Doctor on site dedicated purely to the unit 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The unit provides continuous tertiary care and support for patients with multiple organ failure and complex surgical cases including advanced respiratory support or advanced renal support. All patient care is consultant led and all our staff are highly trained in Critical Care Medicine.

The Resident Doctors on the unit have all had more than a decade of clinical experience with several years in Anaesthesia and Critical Care. They are all independent practitioners with a wealth of experience. We run competitive academic Fellowships where Resident Doctors are supported through higher degrees such as PhDs and MBAs in partnership with University College London.







Imaging

An efficient, safe and dignified experience

Our Diagnostic Imaging Department is equipped with the most advanced technology and equipment. Our team has a wealth of expertise – from our range of consultant radiologists, who are all specialists in their field, to our highly-qualified technical, administrative and support staff.

We don't like to keep our patients waiting. Our turnaround times for reporting are excellent, with more than 80% of reports delivered within 24 hours of the examination being performed.

Whatever tests are required, an efficient, safe and dignified experience can be expected, with results delivered quickly. Our imaging services include:

- 3T and 1.5T MRI scanner
- 2 CT scanners with state of the art cardiac capabilities
- Digital X-ray
- Ultrasound
- DEXA scanner
- Echo cardiology

Physiotherapy

Providing relief and rehabilitation

A carefully planned rehabilitation programme is one of the key aspects of successful recovery, following treatment or surgery. Our physiotherapists can work with patients from the privacy of their hospital bedroom, or in our dedicated physiotherapy unit.

The tailored physiotherapy courses they design provide effective relief and rehabilitation for musculoskeletal, gynaecological and neurological conditions.

Our physiotherapy service includes:

- · Joint and soft tissue mobilisation
- · Pilates and core stability training
- Education and advice on posture and ergonomics
- Acupuncture
- · Pre-operative advice and strengthening
- Pre- and post-operative orthopaedic rehabilitation
- Sports massage
- Taping (including kinesiotape)





Hydrotherapy

Our in-house Hydrotherapy Pool

We have one of the few purpose-built hospital hydrotherapy pools in London.

Hydrotherapy involves carefully planned and supervised exercises in water. Our hydrotherapy facility is well equipped and our hydrotherapy pool, which is heated to 34°C (significantly warmer than a normal swimming pool), provides a warm and relaxed atmosphere for patients to undertake non-weight bearing rehabilitation.

We also offer female-only hydrotherapy sessions.

Benefits of hydrotherapy include:

- · Minimised aches and pains
- · Increased strength
- · Increased flexibility
- · Minimised impact on joints
- · Improved balance and decreased risk of falls

Welcoming self-funding, insured and international patients

We welcome all patients to King Edward VII's Hospital, extending our brand of high quality, safe and effective healthcare to patients across the UK and abroad.

Anyone can self-fund their treatment, taking advantage of a range of fixed-price packages and accessing the very best in specialist treatment without the wait.

We work with all the top insurance providers including Aviva, AXA PPP, Bupa, Cigna and Vitality Health, so those with individual or corporate PMI are able to access the same high standards of care.

A charity supporting veterans of the **Armed Forces**

As a registered charity any surplus we make is reinvested, which includes supporting our award-winning charitable work with veterans of the Armed Forces.

This support comes in the form of a 20% discount on our fees or a 100% means tested grant, which may be for the full cost of treatment. This applies to all Service or ex-Service personnel, their widows, widowers, spouses or ex-spouses.

In 2016 we opened our Centre For Veteran's Health where a multidisciplinary pain team delivers our Pain Management Programme (see opposite).

Pain Management Programme

We help veterans enjoy a greater quality of life by teaching them how to manage pain. The Pain Management Programme (PMP) is an evidence-based programme using tried and tested pain management strategies that have been adapted to meet the specific needs of the veteran population.

The PMP has up to 10 veterans on each programme. Each programme is 10 days long, delivered over a 9 month period, virtually, via Zoom.

The programme is specifically designed to help veterans who have been suffering with chronic pain to get the correct assessment, diagnosis, and pain management techniques they need as quickly as possible.

It is offered free of charge to Veterans from all Services and aims to help them feel empowered and return to life as they knew it, pre-trauma.

Recent feedback from veterans attending the PMP shows:

- 100% of veterans attending PMP would recommend to others'
- 98% rated the programme 5 out of 5
- 95% found all sessions relevant to their needs
- 100% of those seeking employment felt more confident in doing so due to the PMP
