Toiletries (We provide a selection of complimentary toiletries in the room)
Well-fitting slippers/ shoes with backs, or trainers
Swimwear (if using the hydrotherapy pool)
Any specialist dressings or products that you use at home e.g. stoma/incontinence products,
catheters etc.
Mobile phone and charger
Other items you wish to bring with you could include:
Books or magazines
Batteries for hearing aids
